

# New Techious Pre-Meeting Given Ideas

Following on from the Private Message sent out on September 13th, we have the following stats:

- 38 Messages Sent
- 27 Were Read (71%)
- 14 Replies (52% of Read, 37% Total)

From the messages, the following topics are up for discussion, during the meeting people can say yes/no or debate these until we have the New Techious. Note, that these are not the views of any staff or member, just a bullet point representation of ideas given by the 14 (More ideas given will be included):

## Changes to Staff System

- Should the following staff members be removed?
  - DHR
  - Metritutus
  - Wigouche
  - Wynney (described as worse than anyone else for rage!?)
- Who will take over as second in command?
- New Staff System (To be described by Si during the discussion)
- N4M
- Should only Si (and Skillers) have master admin (or any admin in Mumble?)
- Staff should not take sides in petty arguments. (Especially the wrong side)
- Admin based on respect not just "I MAKE YOU ADMIN NOW, GO TAKE OVER EARTH"
- Mods should be more strict for the good of the community. Mute, kick, BAN.
- Some people think they deserve to become staff.
- Give other people full and unrestricted admin over the dedi (what dedi?)

## Changes to Techious Servers

- The current server costs too much (£65 a month)
- The server is too large for current level of activity, with few members (not enough to pay for server), so restructure is needed.
  - If we boost activity then it might be worth it but currently not.
- The new "Server pot" system:
  - Pay for mumble/web server.
  - Rent servers as and when we need it.
- New membership to go with above?
- Remove 99% of mumble channels.
- Crackdown on rage ruining part of the community (in both mumble and servers)
  - Mute/Kick to cooldown
  - Banning of people during inter-clan arguments (too much time wasted on this)
  - Quote from a PM: "Do NOT bring your personal conflicts to our servers or community. No one wants to hear your arguments with someone else. If you have a problem with someone, take it up with them. If trolling/arguments etc. are heard damaging the community individuals involved will be dealt with."
- Make users respect the "unwritten rules" of games. (e.g. in css 2v1 the 2 using awps or in tf2 2v1, the 2 going heavy-med)
- New forum theme (its been in the works)

## Change of Clan

- Down with Clan, up with **TECHIOUS COMMUNITY!**
- Internally (only admins can see) remove non-needed groups (sentimental reasons aren't good
